1. In these Regulations;

- a. "The RDTCAA" means "RAJGAD DNYANPEETH TECHNICAL CAMPUS ALUMNI ASSOCIATION".
- b. "General Body" means the GENERAL BODY OF THE RDTCAA.
- c. "Governing Body" means the body which under these Regulations is constituted to be the Governing body of the RDTCAA.
- d. "President" means the president of the Governing Body.
- e. "Vice-President" the Vice President of Governing body who will look after at association in the absence of President.
- f. "Secretary" means the honorary secretary of the SCSCOEEA.
- g. "Treasurer" shall oversee all the financial matters of the SCSCOEEA.
- h. "ACT" means societies Registration Act, 1860.
- i. Teaching staff means the Professors, Associate Professors, Assistant Professors, Lecturers, Principal employed in the Shree Chhatrapati Shivajiraje College of Engineering, Dhangawadi

Definition of the words used in the Rules and Regulations.

- a.) Society : Society means which is mentioned in Memorandum of Association.
- b.) Objectives:- Objectives means the objectives of the society specified in the memorandum of Association.
- c.) Members:- Means a person who has been accepted Rules & Regulation of the society & who is playing the requisite subscription.
- d.) Society's Registration Act- Means Society's Registration Act 1860 & the rules which comes under this act applicable to this society.
- e.) Managing Committee:-Managing Committee means office bearers responsible for administration of the society.

2) Area of Operation:- The area of operation shall be all over Maharashtra

4). Membership and their registration procedure:-

2. **a) Patron:** The Founder of the Institution, the Chairman and Members of the Governing Body and the Principal of the College shall be Patrons of the Association. The General Body may invite other outstanding personalities to be Patrons of the Association.

b) Life Member: All those former students of the College, who pay an entrance subscription not less than Rs.500/- shall be Life Members. Life Members need not pay any annual subscription.

The outgoing students of the Association may be eligible to become Life Member by paying Rs.500/- in one installment

c) Ordinary Member: All former students who pay an amount of Rs.100/- as entrance fee and Rs.100/- as Annual Subscription shall be ordinary members.

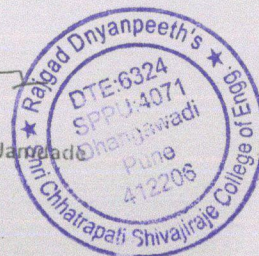
d) Honorary Member: All members of the Teaching Staff of the College shall be Honorary Members of the Association.

a) Founder Member: - 07 Signatories to the Memorandum of Association of the society shall be founder member of the society. The founder

b) General Member: - Any Indian citizen above 18 years of age who wish to work for the organization can become a general member. Annual subscription for such members shall be Rs.50.

6) Cessation and removal of membership:

Cancellation of Membership

Due to following Reasons membership will be terminated:

1. Accidental Death of Member.
2. Acceptance of Resignation by all other members of RDTCAA.
3. Violation of Rules and Regulations of RDTCAA or any other crime performed by the member.
4. In case of failure to pay Annual Registration fees by the member within Three months of each year.

If member fails to attend Extra Ordinary general meeting consecutively more than three times.

The managing committee has right to discontinue the membership of the member.

Following grounds:

- On his/her death.
- On his/her resignation in writing approved by managing committee.
- If the member is convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude. Any person who's activities are considered detrimental to the interest of the society. However the member concerned shall be given an opportunity to be heard before such decision is taken & after that he can be removed from the membership.

- If the member is found acting prejudicially to the interest, preying, & making hindrance to working of the society.
- On remaining absent subsequently for 3 annual meetings without written intimation. This clause shall not be applicable to those who could not attend the meeting for being outside the town of registration.
- If the member leaves the town / country forever.
- **Annual General meeting and its functions:**

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

5. a) A General meeting of the RDTCAA shall be held at least once in every calendar year which shall be called Annual General Meeting (ALUMNI MEET) and not more than 15 months shall elapse between two successive general meetings. All other general meetings shall be called extra ordinary general meetings.
- b) Meeting how convened: General meeting shall be convened by the honorary Secretary and shall at such date and time and place as the Governing Body may decide.
- c) Notice: 14 days notice of the general meeting shall be given in such manner as the Governing Body may decide.
- d) Voting Rights: Every member of the RDTCAA except the student member and honorary member shall have one vote. To exercise this he shall be present in person.
- e) Questions to be Decided by Majority Vote: Every question submitted to a general meeting shall be decided by a majority of votes and in case of equality of votes the chairman of the meeting shall have a second or casting vote. In all cases voting shall be show of hands in the first instance. The poll shall be held in such a manner as the chairman may decide.
- f) Chairman of Meetings: The President of the Governing Body, if present, shall preside at all general meetings. In the absence of the president, the members present may elect one of them to be the Chairman of the meeting.
- g) QUORUM: Unless otherwise decided at a general meeting the quorum of a general meeting shall be 12, members present in person.
- h) Resolutions: A declaration by the chairman that a resolution has been carried or lost and entry to that effect in the books of proceedings of the meetings of the RDTCAA shall be conclusive evidence of that fact.

- i) If at a general meeting convened otherwise then on requisition a quorum is not present within 15 minutes of the time of commencement of the meeting, the same shall stand adjourned to the same day but 2 hours thereafter at the same place.  - Transact such other business as may be brought forward with the permission of president.
 - To write off irrecoverable arrears.
 - Notice of General Body and Quorum:
 - The meeting will be held at a specified date, time & place as decided by managing committee.
- 2) Before Meeting 14' days Notice should be given to member.
- 3) The Notice should be given before 7 days if it is about amendment of rules & regulation
- 4) It will be better if such notice is published in Local Newspaper but it will not be binding
- 5) If such notice is dispatched under certificate of posting & not received such member then it will not make any hindrance to pass the resolutions in any meeting.
- 6) Honorary members and special invitees etc, may be invited to attend and address the general Body Meeting, but they have no right to vote there at.
- 7) The managing committee can adopt to the maximum of 3 member in the committee for any year but they will not have any voting right.

- D) All the regulations applying to general meetings will be mutually applicable to Extra Ordinary general meetings.



10). Managing Committee and it's composition:



11). Period of Managing Committee and Methods of Election:



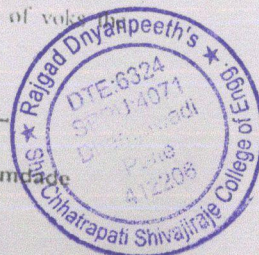

12). Function and rights of the office bearer of Managing Committee

Duties of Governing Body Authorities:

1. President:

The President is the highest officer in the chapter and coordinator of all its activities. The President's leadership and guidance should serve as an inspiration to all members in achieving the objectives of the chapter.

14). Notice and Quorum to Managing committees Meeting:



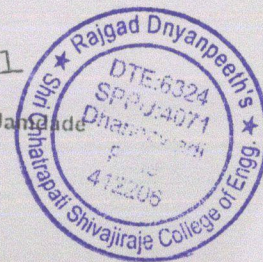
25. Dissolution of the RDTCAA

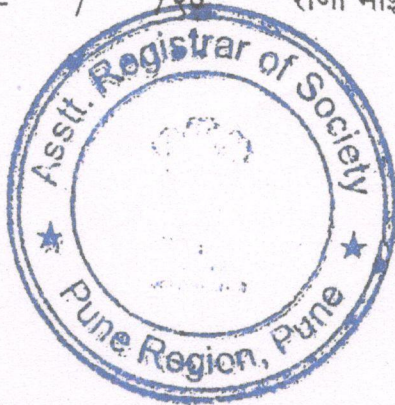
